

Terms and conditions for research

These terms and conditions should be read alongside the terms and conditions for the Global Learning Programme for England.

Data gathered through the GLP will be used to carry out research into global learning in England.

Data gathered through the GLP initial registration and Whole School Audit will be analysed by researchers at the Institute of Education, in order to map practices and impacts of global learning and the GLP in England.

Data analysis will look at large-scale patterns of engagement, so individual schools and individuals within them will not be identifiable. The Institute of Education will produce research reports and other publications based on the data which will add to the knowledge base on global learning and will inform better practice for individual teachers, schools, training providers, policy makers and the GLP team. Copies of research reports will be made available to schools via the GLP website.

Research carried out on data collected via the GLP initial registration, Whole School Audit (and any other relevant GLP activities) complies with the BERA (British Educational Research Association) Ethical Guidelines for Educational Research 2011. In particular:

- any names of individuals and schools will be confidential and anonymised
- data used for the purposes of research will be held within the consortium and not passed onto other organisations or individuals
- data will be held securely.

Data from schools completing the Whole School Audit will be automatically included in the research unless notification is given by schools to indicate otherwise. If participants wish to withdraw their school from the research analysis as described above, or if they would like to discuss the research aspects of the GLP further, please contact glp@pearson.com. Otherwise, individuals and schools will not be contacted for research purposes unless they have ticked the relevant box in the GLP Whole School Audit about involvement in other GLP research activities.
