* The GLP is funded by the UK government. All schools can join the programme, but funding is only available to Key Stages 2 and 3 in state schools in England that have registered for the GLP. Access to up to £500-worth of e-credits is provided on completion of the GLP Whole School Audit, and e-credits are deducted automatically once a course has been attended. The GLP in England (GLP-E) is managed by a consortium of partners: Pearson (lead), Geographical Association, UCL Institute of Education, Oxfam UK, Royal Geographical Society (with IBG), SSAT and Think Global.
